## Kindergarten 2023-2024 Opening Schedule

## WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 30 - HALF DAY

- First day of school for Kindergarteners only. To help children acclimate, this will be a HALF DAY.
- ON AUGUST 30 ONLY, Kindergarten students will arrive between 8:30 and 8:45 am, after our regular drop-off time. This will allow time for saying goodbyes in our "hug zone" outside our main entrance before our Kindergarten team takes children to classrooms. Look for your child's teacher and teaching assistants holding signs indicating where each class should meet near the main entrance / Jesus statue.
- If your Kindergartener will ride the bus to school during the first week of school, please email his/her teacher so arrangements can be made to assist your child in getting to the classroom.
- ALL kindergarten students will attend from 8:45 a.m. to 12:00 pm. There will be no buses to take kindergarten students home on these days and no Latchkey available for kindergarten students these afternoons. Please be sure your child has a ride home.
- ON AUGUST 30 ONLY, Rooms 101 and 102 will be dismissed from the Moorfield Road doors. Room 105 will be dismissed from the doors by the Jesus statue. The child's name should be displayed prominently in the passenger window. Please email the teacher if someone other than a parent will be picking up your child.


## THURSDAY, AUGUST 31 - FULL DAY

- FULL-DAY kindergarten program begins. Please make sure your child has arrangements for lunch, a snack, a rest time towel, and a ride home or Latchkey arrangements at dismissal time.
- Beginning Thursday, August 31, Kindergarteners will report at the same time (between 8:00 and 8:25 am) and follow the same procedures as all other students. These details will be reviewed during Kindergarten Orientation in May and can be found in the School Handbook.


## Conference Details

Conferences will be offered by appointment from 4:00 to 9:00 pm on Wednesday, November 1 and by appointment from 8:30 am to $12: 00 \mathrm{pm}$ on Thursday, November 2. There is no school on Thursday, November 2 and Friday, November 3.
All families are expected to schedule a conference. Conferences for the second semester are optional, to be scheduled as needed.
