- a. School board members were informed of the recent iPad policy compliance audit
  - i. 152 iPads searched

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- 1. 0 violations: 7% (10 of 152)
- 2. Violations: 93% (142 of 152)
  - a. 103 of 152: Non-school related photos / videos or inappropriate photos / videos
  - b. 73 of 152: Non-school related or inappropriate internet searches
  - c. 66 of 152: Gaming
  - d. 45 of 152: Chat Email
  - e. 22 of 152: Shopping
  - f. 18 of 152: Access restricted in internet history
  - g. 7 of 152: Online radio
  - h. 9 of 152: Social Media
  - i. 3 of 152: Cheating
- ii. Take home privileges revoked iPads to stay on campus
  - 1. To take home, parents need to certify compliance
- iii. All homework assignments can be accessed at home with access to a PC or Mac computer
- iv. Changes planned for next year Apple ID's will be set up differently to allow for tighter control and better compliance to policy
- v. Current school Chromebooks have better security limits but also lack the photo / media capabilities of the iPad
