## Welcome New Faces at St. Hilary! Staffing Changes Re-capped

Welcome to all of our many new students and their families! We also extend a special welcome to our new staff members. We have several changes to our faculty and staff for the new school year!

Mrs. Andrea Schiavoni will join Mr. Manno and Mrs. Starkey on the third grade teaching team. Prior to teaching third grade at St. Columbkille School for the past 7 years, Mrs. Schiavoni completed her student teaching at St. Hilary with Mrs. Starkey, so we are excited to have her back with us. A magna cum laude graduate of the University of Akron, Mrs. Schiavoni has certifications in early childhood education and early childhood intervention specialist.

In addition, our current seventh and eighth grade math teacher, Mr. Dougherty, will move to sixth grade to teach math, along with eighth grade social studies. Mrs. Taylor Sanders has been hired to teach math to grades seven and eight, with a seventh grade homeroom. Mrs. Sanders comes to us from Walsh Jesuit High School, where she has taught algebra II and pre-calculus for the past 3 years, along with serving in other leadership and coaching roles. Mrs. Sanders holds a bachelor's degree from Walsh University with licensure in adolescent to young adult grades 7-12 integrated mathematics.

Mr. Sherry will now have an eighth grade homeroom. Other teachers in grades 6, 7 and 8 will change subjects from those they previously taught: Miss Buzzi will now teach sixth grade English and social studies, while Mrs. Hoffman will teach sixth grade science and seventh grade religion. Mr. Gadus will teach 7th grade English and reading.

Our intervention specialist, Mr. Drought, will continue to assist in several classes, including math, as he has during Mrs. Griesse's maternity leave.

Mrs. Campbell has taken a full-time teaching position at another school, and Mrs. Monica Villarreal has been hired to teach Spanish for grades K-8. Mrs. Villarreal is a native speaker who holds a bachelor's degree in industrial engineering from Universidad Tecnologica de Pereira in Colombia. She has extensive experience teaching English as a second language and has assisted at St. Hilary as a substitute teacher and in other roles. She most recently taught Spanish at St. Vincent Elementary School.

Mrs. Jessica Kwieciak has been hired as a part-time teaching assistant in Mrs. Holland's kindergarten class, and Mrs. Shelly Kohrs will absorb all of the teaching assistant duties in Miss Di-Pronio's first grade class. Both Mrs. Kwieciak and Mrs. Kohrs have assisted in many roles at our school, and we are excited to have them on our staff.

Finally, Ms. Nicole Becher will join Mrs. Eldred in the school counseling office during Mrs. Parisi's medical leave. Ms. Becher comes to us through PSI, a contracted company which provides many of our ancillary services.
