Choosing a High School for Your Child

Starting the Process - 7th grade

☐ Begin educating yourself when your son or daughter is in 7th grade
□ Catholic or public?
☐ What is important? (Location, athletics, drama, art, specific offerings, etc.)
☐ What is best for your child and your family?
☐ Resources: School websites and admissions directors
☐ Open Houses – choose what works for your family (see dates attached)
□ 7th grade visitations – students go as a class for the day February 23, 2017: St. Vincent-St. Mary High School March 23, 2017: Walsh Jesuit High School April 4, 2017: Archbishop Hoban High School April 27, 2017: Our Lady of the Elms High School (only girls visit)
$\hfill\Box$ Go to school sponsored events (athletic competitions, plays) to get a "feel" for the school
\square By the end of 7th grade you should have an idea of your child's top 2 schools
Application Process - 8th grade
□ Placement exams at the schools your child is considering (can take at multiple schools for practice if your child is not a strong test taker – see dates attached) Register online or by calling school in advance – all have fees
□ St. Hilary School excuses 2 high school visitation days (shadow days) *To avoid missing school, try to shadow on days when St. Hilary is not in session (suggested dates: October 14, November 11) *Call the schools or go online and book early - spots fill up quickly *No shadowing January 9, 2017 through January 30, 2017 – "quiet" period – you car contact schools for info but they can no longer actively recruit your child
□ January 9-12, 2017 – Diocesan high school selection week and application due *NEW DIOCESAN APPLICATION FORMAT WAS INTRODUCED IN 2012 *Everyone completes only the Diocesan application for admission (this is new for those who have been through this process prior to 2012!) *Some schools require their own application(s) for scholarships – you will receive information about applications and specific deadlines from schools you visit – information is also available on school websites
