The above schedule is suggested to help balance group sizes. However, if your child is unable to come during his or her designated time, please have him or her come during the opposite time. Room 101 will be dismissed from the Moorfield Road doors. Room 102 will be dismissed from the doors by the Jesus statue. There will be no buses to take kindergarten students home on this day and no Latchkey available for kindergarten students this afternoon. Please be sure your child has a ride home.



On Friday, August 26, Monday, August 29, Tuesday, August 30 and Wednesday, August 31, ALL kindergarten students will attend from 8:20 a.m. to 12:00 noon. Room 101 will be dismissed from the Moorfield Road doors. Room 102 will be dismissed from the doors by the Jesus statue. There will be no buses to take kindergarten students home on these days and no Latchkey available for kindergarten students these afternoons.

On Thursday, September 1, the FULL-DAY kindergarten program begins. Please make sure your child has arrangements for lunch, a rest time towel, and a ride home or Latchkey arrangements at dismissal time.
