II. Los sustantivos plurales / Plural Nouns

To form the plural nouns in Spanish follow this simple rules:

1. If the noun **ends with a vowel** (a,e,i,o,u), **add letter S** to the singular form.
Example: Gorroo - Gorros (hats)
2. If the noun **ends in consonant**, **add ES** to the singular form of the noun.
Example: Pantalónn - pantaloneses (pants)
3. If the noun **ends in z**, **change z for C and add ES** to the singular form of the noun.
Example: Pezz - Peceses (fish)
4. If the noun ends with "**s**" or "**x**", **it does not change in the plural**.
Example: luness - luness tijerass-tijerasas(scissors) tórax - tórax (thorax/chest)

Note: Singular nouns **which end in an accented vowel (´)** drop the accent in the plural.
Example: Canción - Canciones (songs)

Artículos Definidos/ Definite Articles

“The”..... “el”, “la”, “los”, “las”

In Spanish, as in English, there are definite articles.

Definite articles are used when you are talking about a specific noun or groups of nouns.

In Spanish, **the article you use depends on the gender of the noun** that follows it.

“The” in English is called definite article.

In Spanish, the definite article for nouns in singular form is either:

el or la

elmasculine- singular

lafeminine- singular

Examples:

- ★ sol (sun)
gender : **masculine**
then use masculine singular definite article: el
el sol / the sun
- ★ lluvia (rain)
gender: feminine
then use the feminine singular definite article: la
la lluvia / the rain

In Spanish, the definite article for nouns in plural form is either:

los or las

losmasculine-plural

las.....feminine-plural

Examples:

- ★ perros (dogs) singular : perroo
therefore gender: **masculine**
then use the masculine-plural definite article: los
Los perros / the dogs
- ★ Casas (houses) singular: casaa
Gender: feminine
Use the feminine-plural definite article: las
Las casas / the houses.



1. In a wide saucepan on medium heat, add the oil and saute the onion slices, when onions are transparent, add salsa and stir, heat the salsa for about 3 min.
2. Crack the eggs and add one by one to the saucepan carefully not to break them, add salt and pepper and cilantro on top of each egg and cover with lid to cook for 4 min.
4. If you have corn tortillas, in another saucepan melt butter and heat the tortillas on it. Take them out and line on a plate.
5. Spoon out each egg with salsa and put it on top of the tortilla.
6. Garnish with jalapeño slices or avocado if you like!
