Frequently Asked Questions

Where and when will my child be picked up in the morning??

Highland provides driveway pickup and drop-off. You will receive a postcard with information about your child's bus number and morning pickup time.

When will my child arrive at home after school?

Afternoon drop off times are not included on the postcard. You will need to put your child on the bus and watch the first week or so to get an idea of when he/she will arrive at home in the afternoon.

I didn't get the postcard! What do I do?

The postcards usually arrive 1-2 days prior to the start of school. If you don't receive one, call the Transportation Department.

General Information

- Highland bus riders are dismissed at 2:55PM (first bell).
- Highland transportation coordinates with the St. Hilary schedule, with the exception of Early Dismissal days, when there is no afternoon busing.
- Parents should contact Transportation Department directly for day-to-day concerns.
- Please take the time to discuss courteous and safe behavior on the bus with your child.

Inclement Weather Policies

- There are no buses on days when Highland is not in session due to inclement weather, regardless of whether or not St. Hilary School is in session.
- If Highland is delayed, then the buses will run, but on the same delayed schedule. Parents who still wish to have their students picked up in the event of a delay need to call the Transportation Department.
- Parents who wish to sign up for text alerts should do so at both Channel 3 and Fox 8 News, in case only one station receives information of a closing.
