

# Guidelines

## ALL TRIPS

Round trip bus transportation is included in prices.

Driver's tip will be collected during each trip.

\$1 per passenger is customary.

You must be at the designated pick-up location at least 15 minutes before listed departure time and check in with the travel coordinator. If you are not there at the departure time the bus may leave without you.

## REGISTRATION

Most trips sell out, so please don't wait to register.

Alternatively, trips could cancel if there aren't enough seats sold 30 days prior to the trip. Take advantage of early bird prices on casino trips.

**REFUND POLICY: No refunds can be given for a cancellation 3 days or less prior to the trip. We understand unforeseen circumstances; ask for details about trip insurance if this is a concern.**

***PLEASE NOTE: Only one check per trip. You are no longer allowed to pay for multiple trips on the same check.***

## **CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS**

Full refunds will be given only if a trip does not sell well enough to go. **You will not get a refund if you cancel 3 days or less before the trip FOR ANY REASON.** We will do our best to find a replacement. Travel insurance is offered through the travel company for overnight trips. It is optional, but the only way to guarantee a refund.

## **CASINOS**

A casino's bonus is determined by the casino and is not guaranteed by MCSAS, Brunswick Rec, or the bus company. **The bonus may change without notice.** Casinos require a valid photo ID to receive the bonus package. **Don't forget to bring your casino Player's Card # when you sign up.**

### **Medina Departure Location:**

Regal Cinema at 200 Reagan Pkwy. Park at the south end of the parking lot. The very last row against the trees.

### **Brunswick Departure Location:**

Brunswick Rec at 3637 Center Rd. Park in the back lot, not the library lot or handicapped spaces.
