Just days after St. Hilary School closed the door on its 60th anniversary year, construction began that would open new doors - literally - for the school. Thanks to funding from the St. Hilary Parish Foundation and St. Hilary Parents' Association, the summer of 2021 was a busy one at the school, with extensive renovation to the school's main entrance and office spaces. The entrance from the parking lot was enlarged and enclosed, allowing for two sets of locked doors with a vestibule area, to permit greater building security. Inside, a large classroom was transformed into the new school office space, housing a secretarial / reception area, staff mailboxes, a conference room, copier, staff workspace, and ample storage. The new office location immediately inside the entrance replaced the previous office space, which was accessible only after walking through the main corridor of the building. The previous school office space continues to house administrative offices and the school clinic, but is now also home to a dedicated intervention services space where students can receive tutoring and various therapies to better serve them and help them succeed. With a total project cost of \$259,339, the St. Hilary Parish Foundation underwrote \$140,000 of the cost, while the St. Hilary Parents' Association funded \$100,000.





THE FUTURE BEGINS HERE

On the heels of the school's 60th anniversary celebration honoring the past, projects such as this help to ensure that the school's tagline, "The Future Begins Here", remains true as time marches forward. But the Foundation doesn't simply provide funding for brick-and-mortar projects. Knowing that a school is truly built upon the people inside it, next month, the Foundation will offer a slate of 16 scholarships totaling \$26,600 for which students returning to the school in 2022-2023 may apply. Begun in December 2015 for the 2016-2017 school year, the Foundation's ambitious scholarship initiative has awarded 102 scholarships totaling \$201,700 since its inception. Of these, 18 scholarships, totaling \$26,600, were awarded in 2021. These scholarships provide funds to students who are selected based on meeting the criteria established by the scholarship donors. They include the Friend of St. Hilary Scholarship, the Mother Teresa Scholarship, the Sr. Carol Joy Scholarship, the St. Aloysius Scholarship, the St. Hilary R.E.D. Scholarship, the Striving Saber Scholarship, the Ralph and Florence Bernard Scholarship, the Rev. Steven Brunovsky Catholic Leadership Scholarship, the Edward L. Gilbert Family Scholarship, and the St. Hilary Parish Foundation Tuition Assistance Scholarship. For the students and families who receive these scholarships, the additional funds often mean the difference between being able to continue a St. Hilary School education and needing to look for another option.

DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE:

When was the last time you mentioned the grade school you attended? Usually, when the question of school comes up, people quite naturally talk about where they went to college or gush about their

high school days. I almost never hear people talk about where they went to grade school, do you?

If you think about it, elementary school is actually where our future begins. It is the place that prepares us for our high school, college and life experiences. It's those patient teachers, helpful aides, responsible administrators, energetic playground monitors, and friendly office and maintenance staff who helped to create the early foundation for our later successes. St. Hilary School educators encourage curiosity and inspire creativity, while introducing rules and self-discipline. They do this along with fostering the growth of students' faith and helping them to develop life-long social skills and friendships. It has been part of the educational foundation for our children for over 60 years, and has shaped the future for more than 3,500 boys and girls since 1960.

My two sons, Chris and Ben, are graduates of St. Hilary School, and my husband and I are very grateful for the exceptional education they received. St. Hilary helped to prepare them well for their futures at Archbishop Hoban High School, the University of Notre Dame for Chris and The Ohio State University for Ben. St. Hilary's outstanding faith-filled curriculum, athletics, clubs, and service helped to build skills and character that carried them forward to successful and meaningful careers - Chris as a pediatrician and Ben as a commodities trader. It has been years since my sons attended St. Hilary, and the current curriculum and campus have been greatly enhanced over the years through support from the St. Hilary Parish Foundation to provide new technology, school improvements, programs, and much more. These grants from the Foundation have helped to keep the future viable for students at St. Hilary School for years to come.

The Foundation has supported our school and church since 1976. Over the past 45 years, the future of St. Hilary Parish has depended on the generosity of parishioners, school parents, alumni, and families of our community to the St. Hilary Parish Foundation. Beginning with seed money from founding pastor Fr. Edward Horning and generous contributions of approximately \$400,000 in 1976, the Foundation has grown to over \$11 million today. Most importantly, the Foundation has been able to secure the future by granting over \$4.5 million to address the many

needs of our church and school throughout the years.

We have achieved a great deal since 1976, but there is much left to be done. We are truly grateful for gifts large and small, and recognize that your generosity has a lasting impact on the future of the St. Hilary community. MEMORIAL AND TRIBUTE SCHOLARSHIPS RECOGNIZE STUDENTS

Some of the scholarships supported by the St. Hilary Parish Foundation and its donors are awarded without students or families applying for them, simply because the recipients are recognized as bearing qualities reminiscent of the individuals the scholarships honor, or because they embody ideals the scholarships promote.

The Kevin Thomas Neff Scholarship honors St. Hilary School graduate Kevin Neff, who died of a brain tumor while in high school, and annually provides a \$1,250 scholarship to a seventh grader who exemplifies the characteristics Kevin aspired to during his life. In the 2020-2021 school year, the Kevin Thomas Neff Scholarship was awarded to Madeline Solomon.

The Jane Klenotic Scholarship honors long-time St. Hilary School second grade teacher Jane Klenotic, who lost her battle with cancer in 2014, and annually awards a \$1,000 scholarship to a second grader who has the attributes of spiritual, academic and personal character that were important to Jane. Jude Slanina was the second grader chosen to receive the 2020-2021 Jane Klenotic Scholarship.

The Jimmy Lyons Geography Bee Scholarship Fund was begun in memory of St. Hilary School 2006 graduate Jimmy Lyons, who was a four-time winner of the school's geography bee and a state bee competitor, and passed away in 2011. This \$500 scholarship is awarded to the winner of the school's geography bee each year. No geography bee was held in 2021 due to COVID-19, so no scholarship was awarded.

Finally, two \$500 St. Hilary Athletic Association scholarships are awarded through the Foundation each year to two St. Hilary School eighth grade student athletes who meet a slate of athletic, academic, and character requirements. The scholarships are applied to the recipients' high school tuition. In May 2021, Daniel Bisesi and Finley Kennedy received these scholarships.
