ANSWERING GOD'S CALL IN A CHANGING WORLD




If you've been on this earth for any amount of time, you know each year, in fact each month, week, and day, brings change. It would be difficult to dispute, though, that 2020 has brought more change to our world than most of us have seen in our lifetimes. These are challenging times we are living in – so challenging that some have even questioned the deeper message being sent to us. What, we may wonder, is God trying to tell us?

God calls us to do many things in our lives. In 1976, Fr. Edward Horning and a small group of St. Hilary parishioners answered God's call to plan for the long term needs of St. Hilary School and Church. With seed money from Fr. Horning and generous contributions from parishioners, more than \$400,000 was raised to start the St. Hilary Parish Foundation. Currently standing at \$9,426,802.96, the Foundation was created for times such as we are living in now. If planning for the future means planning for the proverbial rainy day, in 2020, it has not only been raining, it has been pouring. Thankfully, through the foresight of Fr. Horning and the parishioners from 1976, the Foundation has been there to help.

Foundation Assists During Year of Change

Just in the year since November 1, 2019, the St. Hilary Parish Foundation has funded a lengthy list of items to help the parish and school during this trying time. Most notably, the Foundation provided \$121,981.26 to underwrite tuition assistance, a tuition freeze, and kindergarten and first grade fees, in an effort to support school families dealing with fiscal fallout from COVID-19. Additional assistance for the school came in the purchase of Chromebooks and cases totaling \$60,368.83, scholarships totaling \$30,500.00, a new phone system at \$11,033.87, and a steam table and warming oven for the school kitchen for \$3,187.84. On the parish side, the Foundation covered \$66,300.00 in remodeling costs for the Spiritual Center, chairs for the choir at \$22,178.20, new accordion partitions for the Spiritual Center meeting rooms totaling \$21,875.00, a new phone system at \$14,835.79, evangelization costs of \$12,400.07, a new projector in the church for \$9,779.90, new folding tables and an ice machine for the recently remodeled kitchen totaling \$4,774.70, and an automatic handicap accessible door at \$4,640.00. Some of these items were underway before COVID-19 shook our world, but many were funded as a direct result of the pandemic and its many ancillary effects.



DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE:

A Foundation Built For Uncertain Times

It's been a year like never before. Reflecting on the past year, it has been one filled with uncertainty and instability. Our world has gone through many changes since we welcomed 2020 with great hope and

excitement. It has been a year filled with fear, challenges, disappointments, and sadness, but it has also given us moments of joy, hope, and new beginnings.

As for me, joy came in the blessing of my first grandchild – a baby boy named Finnegan. He gives me hope for the future. When the time comes that he asks about my memories of 2020, there are many things I'll be able to tell him about: the tragedy of the lives lost; the bravery of the doctors, nurses and essential workers; the constant hand washing and mask wearing; fighting for justice; and how communities came together to help each other.

Many of the changes the world has gone through have directly impacted our St. Hilary community in ways we could not have imagined less than a year ago. This past spring, Fr. Steve presented the Foundation with additional tuition assistance and technology needs related to the COVID-19 challenges facing St. Hilary School, and the Foundation was more than willing to help. To address the needs presented, the Foundation granted funds of nearly \$122,000 to cover tuition assistance, a tuition freeze, and kindergarten and first grade fees, as well as over \$60,000 for Chromebooks to assist St. Hilary School students with in-person and distance learning. This funding totaled more than \$182,000, and was in addition to \$35,500 in scholarships that are awarded annually through the Foundation. Also, in addition to helping with the current and critical needs of the school, we were able to go forward with granting over \$88,000 for Spiritual Center renovations, as well as other projects that were already planned prior to the pandemic and are listed in detail within this report.

If this year has taught us anything, it's that we need to be prepared for the uncertainty of the future. With your help, the Foundation can continue to be the safety net that will support our church and school in the face of the unforeseen challenges in our changing world. In order for the Foundation to be able to continue to provide financial backing for our parish now and in the future, I ask that you please prayerfully consider making a donation to one of our many funds, or be one of 52 world changers needed to complete our Crystal Commemorative window (details on page 5). With your help, we can celebrate the completion of the Crystal Commemorative campaign as we celebrate the 60th anniversary of St. Hilary School.

There is no question that the challenges of 2020 are significant. Fortunately, the Foundation was created to help in times just like these. I welcome the opportunity to discuss giving options with you to help build our funds, so that together we can continue to change the world at St. Hilary for years to come. **ANSWER GOD'S CALL:
HOW WILL YOU CHANGE THE WORLD?**



PASTOR'S MESSAGE:

The Latin word *vocare* means "to call". From this word comes the word *vocation*, namely how one lives his or her life in response to God's call. This year at St. Hilary School, our theme is "Answer God's Call...Change the World!" We are reflecting on the life of St. Katharine Drexel, the first US-born person named a saint in the Catholic Church. You may have also noticed a banner depicting St. Katharine Drexel in the church. Katharine was born in 1858 in Philadelphia into the wealthy Drexel banking family. But wealth did not shield her from life's sorrows. Her mother died when she was only five days old, and her stepmother died of cancer when Katharine was a young woman. After reading about the mistreatment of Native Americans in Helen Hunt's book, *A Century of Dishonor*, Katharine became interested in using her influence to help both Native American and African American youth obtain the educational opportunities that she had enjoyed. While visiting Italy, she met with Pope Leo the 13th, and asked him to send missionaries to begin this work. He said to her, "Why don't you become a missionary yourself?!" Katharine was stunned! But the seed was planted, and in 1889 Katharine began the work of entering religious life, and starting her own order, The Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament, with the express mission of educating Native American children out West, and African American children in the South. It can be said without a doubt that in answering God's call, Katharine changed the world for the good!

How might God be calling you? Are you willing to answer that call? How will your response change the lives of others, and the world, for the good?

For many years, faithful parishioners of St. Hilary Parish have answered God's call to support the work of the Parish and School. Whether for a specific capital project, a scholarship, a particular ministry, or the general support of the mission of the Church, these donors to the St. Hilary Parish Foundation have enabled the work of teaching, evangelization, worship, and service that has led to the transformation of many lives! This year, St. Hilary School is celebrating its 60th anniversary! Imagine the gift of Catholic education that has been provided to countless students. The parish has 24 social justice ministries. FOUNDATION SUPPORTS SCHOOL THROUGH TIME OF CHANGE

A warming oven was added to the school kitchen to help with adjusted lunch delivery procedures due to COVID-19.

Begun in December 2015 for the 2016-2017 school year, the Foundation's ambitious scholarship initiative has awarded 84 scholarships totaling \$140,100 since its inception. Of these, 16 scholarships, totaling \$26,500, were awarded in 2020. These scholarships provide funds to students who are selected based on meeting the criteria established by the scholarship donors. They include the Friend of St. Hilary Scholarship, the Mother Teresa Scholarship, the Sr. Carol Joy Scholarship, the St. Aloysius Scholarship, the St. Hilary R.E.D. Scholarship, the Striving Saber Scholarship, the Ralph and Florence Bernard Scholarship, the Rev. Steven Brunovsky Catholic Leadership Scholarship, the Edward L. Gilbert Family Scholarship, and the St. Hilary Parish Foundation Tuition Assistance Scholarship. For the students and families who receive these scholarships, the additional funds often mean the difference between being able to continue a St. Hilary School education and needing to look for another option. The names of the recipients are not published in order to protect their privacy, as many of these scholarships are based on financial need.

Memorial and Tribute Scholarships Recognize Students

Some of the scholarships supported by the St. Hilary Parish Foundation and its donors are awarded without the students or families applying for them, simply because the recipients are recognized as bearing qualities reminiscent of the individuals the scholarships honor, or because they embody ideals the scholarships promote.

The Kevin Thomas Neff Scholarship honors St. Hilary School graduate Kevin Neff, who died of a brain tumor while in high school, and annually

provides a \$1,250 scholarship to a seventh grader who exemplifies the characteristics Kevin aspired to during his life. In the 2019-2020 school year, the Kevin Thomas Neff Scholarship was awarded to Finley Kennedy.

The Jane Klenotic Scholarship honors long-time St. Hilary School second grade teacher Jane Klenotic, who lost her battle with cancer in 2014, and annually awards a \$1,000 scholarship to a second grader who has the attributes of spiritual, academic and personal character that were important to Jane. Ava Inglett was the second grader chosen to receive the 2019-2020 Jane Klenotic Scholarship.

The Jimmy Lyons Geography Bee Scholarship Fund was begun in memory of St. Hilary School 2006 graduate Jimmy Lyons, who was a four-time winner of the school's geography bee and a state bee competitor, and passed away in 2011. This \$500 scholarship is awarded to the winner of the school's geography bee each year. In January 2020, Brennan Albainy qualified for the award.

Additionally, two \$500 St. Hilary Athletic Association scholarships are awarded through the Foundation each year to two St. Hilary School eighth grade student athletes who meet a slate of athletic, academic, and character requirements. The scholarships are applied to the recipients' high school tuition. In May 2020, Adam Bentley and Cate Werckman received these scholarships.

Underwriting Other Needs

In addition to directly supporting students through tuition assistance and scholarships, the Foundation also

grants funding for general, tangible school needs and amenities. In 2020, items funded for the school have included Chromebooks and cases for students in multiple grades at just over \$60,300, a new phone system at just over \$11,000, a new steam table and warming oven for the school kitchen at just under \$3,200, and rosary gifts for departing 8th grade families at just over \$400. The Chromebooks and kitchen equipment have been incredibly helpful as the school navigates new ways of teaching and learning, as well as new ways of safely providing hundreds of student lunches each day, during the pandemic.

Tuition assistance, scholarships and other projects would not be possible without the generosity of donors who answer God's call through their contributions to the St. Hilary Parish Foundation. The Foundation relies upon each donor to build its funds and enable continued support of St. Hilary School and its students. With the present and future needs of both the school and the parish in mind, the Foundation must work to maintain its resources at levels that will allow it to keep pace with these financial demands and safeguard the future. Your support is greatly valued, for without it our school and our parish would not be able to provide the many features from which our St. Hilary community benefits. 

CRYSTAL COMMEMORATIVES: WILL YOU ANSWER GOD'S CALL TO SUSTAIN OUR SCHOOL?







Thanks to those who have answered God's call over the years, the St. Hilary Parish Foundation was poised to support St. Hilary School through a time of change this year as COVID-19 gripped our world. Making sure that St. Hilary School students continue to receive the excellent Catholic education for which the school is known requires the support of hundreds of generous individuals who have chosen to donate to the St. Hilary Parish Foundation.

In 2020, the Foundation tapped into this generosity once again to help the school through this challenging time. To ensure that a St. Hilary School education is an affordable reality for students and their families, the Foundation stepped up to provide just under \$122,000 in funds for tuition assistance, a tuition freeze, and the underwriting of kindergarten and first grade fees. This assistance included helping school families struggling with the financial effects of COVID-19 to pay off 2019-2020 tuition, as well as supporting families for the 2020-2021 school year. Because of the tuition freeze implemented on May 1, this generous gift directly aided every St. Hilary School family for the 2020-2021 school year.

Scholarships Provide Additional Assistance

Next month, the Foundation will offer a slate of 16 scholarships totaling \$26,600.00 for which students returning to the school in 2021-2022 may apply.






