We live in a world where abundant blessings surround us. From the sky above us, to the natural beauty that envelops us, to the food that nourishes us, we are richly blessed by these and so many other facets of life. The St. Hilary Parish Foundation is abundantly blessed by those who have shared their gifts and enabled the Foundation to underwrite an array of needs and amenities for our parish and school. With over \$8.6 million in holdings, Foundation funds make it possible to eliminate the need for requests for donations to be made from the pulpit during Masses. In the past year, there has been an especially large slate of items for which the Foundation has been blessed to provide a total of \$374,401.58 in funding.

Subsidizing Facility Renovation and Repair

The costliest and most significant project funded by the St. Hilary Parish Foundation this year was the replacement of the roof over a large portion of the school, including the school office and clinic, two classrooms, and the Media Center. One of many separate roof systems sheltering the school, this section of roof had experienced ongoing leaks that became progressively worse during the 2017-2018 school year. A process was initiated in January to begin researching the best option to

replace the roof and solicit bids. The roof was ultimately replaced during the summer, including a complete tear-off of the old roof and installation of new materials to ensure a waterproof seal. The Foundation contributed \$132,740.96 to the total project cost. The conclusion of work coincided with the beginning of the school year in August. With numerous rain storms since then, the roof has proven to be leak-free. The Spiritual Center kitchen also received a makeover, with the installation of new cabinetry, countertops and appliances. Originally built in 1990, the kitchen receives extensive use for various parish and school events. Funeral luncheons, parish gatherings, and breakfast and lunch events for students and parents are just a few of the functions for which this kitchen is used. With the Spiritual Center serving as a hub of daily life at St. Hilary, the original kitchen was well-used for nearly three decades. The Spiritual Center kitchen remodel, as well as a smaller facelift to the kitchen in the rectory, cost a total of \$81,713.89.

Additional facility updates included several flooring projects. New carpet and tile was installed in the Spiritual Center Meeting Rooms and Lower Level, at a total of \$23,845.00. These rooms are used daily for meetings and other events, and flooring in these areas, dating back to the original construction of the Spiritual Center in 1990, was showing visible wear and tear. In equally poor, if not worse, condition was the carpeting in the school office. Rippled and loose from water damage, and worn and faded

from heavy foot traffic, the wall-to-wall carpet was replaced with more functional carpet tiles, enabling any areas that might sustain damage or staining to simply be individually excised and replaced. The cost of this project was \$3,532.00. Two other areas of the school in which carpet was replaced were the Spanish Room and the Teachers' Lounge, each of which double as meeting rooms for both the school and the parish in the evening. Carpet in these two areas cost \$6,608.00. Flooring was also replaced in the Sacristy for \$2,600.00.

Rounding out the list of facility upgrades were several perhaps less noticeable projects, including the replacement of a boiler at the convent for \$6,000.00, the re-glazing of the large stained glass window in the rear of the church for \$2,265.00, and the replacement of acoustic treatment flanking that window for \$10,340.00. The stained glass window had been leaking, and re-glazing it and replacing the timeworn acoustic treatment surrounding it completes the updating

DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE:

What are you abundantly grateful for? Is it your friends and family? Your faith? Your education? Your job? As the Development Director at the St. Hilary Parish Foundation, I feel abundant gratitude for the amenities the Foundation has been blessed

to provide for the St. Hilary community because of the generous support of our donors!

October 2018 marked my 15th year as Development Director of the St. Hilary Parish Foundation. I am truly grateful for the many blessings I have been given these last 15 years – personally and professionally. During that time, your generous support, as well as the management of our funds with investment and distribution policies set forth by the Foundation's Board of Trustees, have enabled the Foundation's assets to grow from \$1.3 million in 2003 to over \$8.6 million in 2018. At the same time, we have been able to distribute nearly \$2.19 million in grants for capital and operating needs, scholarships, tuition assistance, evangelization, religious vocations, technology, and security.

Since its inception, the Foundation has invested more than \$3.59 million in the church and school. This year alone, through your selfless generosity, we have received donations of just over \$368,350 and have distributed a little more than \$374,400 to the church and the school.

None of this would have been possible had it not been for the generosity of our many donors, as well as the commitment of the Foundation's Board of Trustees. I feel abundant gratitude for being able to be a part of the Foundation these past 15 years and for the generosity of all of the donors who have made possible the Foundation's growth and its ability to provide support to the church and school. Whether you have donated \$20 or have given a major gift, please know that your gifts mean the world to us, and without your continued support and commitment, we would not be able to grow our unrestricted and restricted funds to enable the Foundation to distribute necessary dollars to meet the needs of our church and school.

Even as we have provided for the past and present needs of the St. Hilary community, the Foundation must continue to grow its resources for the needs of tomorrow. Sound financial management principles dictate that only a small percentage of Foundation earnings can be distributed each year, in order to continue to maintain the integrity and growth of the funds held by the Foundation. Therefore, continued donations are vital to sustain the work of the Foundation. To that end, I would be abundantly grateful if you would consider a gift to one of our many designated funds, establish a family named fund to address a need within the St. Hilary community that is important to you, or consider a donation to enable us to complete the Crystal Commemoratives school endowment campaign (see page 4 for details). Through your support and commitment to the Foundation, we will continue to make a difference at St. Hilary now and in the future.

Wish List

Would you like to fund a specific need of the St. Hilary community? One item requiring funding is of particular need: technology upgrades in the St. Hilary School classrooms, including replacement of aging Smart-Boards with current educational technology, as well as new computers for teachers' use. Over the past several years, technology for individual student use has been improved greatly, with the addition of hundreds of iPads and Chromebooks, including 1:1 devices for students in grades 6, 7 and 8. However, SmartBoards throughout the school are approaching 15 years old and parts to repair them are either no longer available or so costly that they exceed the value of the devices themselves. These, along with antiquated computers teachers are still using on a daily basis, need to be replaced in order to maintain a technologically current learning environment in the school classrooms. It would be ideal to equip each teacher with a desktop computer to use in the classroom, as well as a tablet device to use in the many meetings and trainings teachers must attend. Contemporary interactive board technology, such as the Promethean Board, is desirable to replace the school's aging SmartBoards and provide students and teachers with a frontline tool widely used in educational and workplace settings today.



Planned Giving is Focus of Legacy Society



FOUNDATION'S BLESSINGS ALLOW ABUNDANT



An abundance of support is needed to ensure that St. Hilary School students continue to receive the excellent Catholic education for which the school is known. Through the graciousness of donors sharing their blessings with the St. Hilary Parish Foundation, the Foundation in turn has been able to help support the school and its students for over 40 years. In 2018, the Foundation renewed its commitment to making a St. Hilary School education an affordable reality for students and their families. The Foundation provided \$25,000 in funds to supplement the more than \$150,000 the Parish already commits to tuition assistance each year. This generous gift directly aided 18 students who might otherwise not have been able to attend St. Hilary School during the 2018-2019 school year.

An Abundance of Scholarships In December 2015, the St. Hilary Parish Foundation debuted its vast scholar-ship initiative for the 2016-2017 school year. Next month, the Foundation will again offer a slate of 18 scholarships totaling \$26,500 for which students returning to the school in 2019-2020 may apply. To date, through this initiative, the Foundation has awarded a total of 52 scholarships totaling \$87,000, with 18 of those, totaling \$26,500, being awarded in 2018. These scholarships provide funds to students who are selected based on meeting the criteria established by the scholarship donors. They include the Friend of St. Hilary Scholarship, the Mother Teresa Scholarship, the Sr. Carol Joy Scholarship, the St. Aloysius Scholarship, the St. Hilary R.E.D. Scholarship, the Striving Saber Scholarship, the Ralph and Florence Bernard Scholarship, the Rev. Steven Brunovsky Catholic Leadership Scholarship, the Edward L. Gilbert Family Scholarship, and the St. Hilary Parish Foundation Tuition Assistance Scholarship. Names of the students who receive

these scholarships are not published in order to protect the privacy of their families, as many of these scholarships are based on financial need. For the students and families who receive these generous gifts of assistance, the scholarships often mean the difference between being able to continue a St. Hilary School education and needing to look for another option.

Sharing Blessings and

Some of the scholarships supported by the St. Hilary Parish Foundation and its donors are awarded without the students or families applying for them, simply because the recipients are recognized as bearing qualities reminiscent of the individuals the scholarships honor, or because they embody ideals the scholarships promote. These include the Kevin Thomas Neff Scholarship, the Jane Klenotic Scholarship, the Jimmy Lyons Geography Bee Scholarship, and the St. Hilary Athletic Association Scholarship. While the Athletic Association Scholarship is directed to eighth grade recipients' high school tuition, each of the other scholarships is applied directly to awardees' St. Hilary School tuition.

The Kevin Thomas Neff Scholarship honors St. Hilary School graduate Kevin Neff, who died of a brain tumor while in high school. Through the Kevin Thomas Neff Scholarship Fund, the Foundation annually awards a \$1,250 scholarship to a seventh grader at the school who exemplifies the characteristics Kevin aspired to during his life. In the 2017-2018 school year, the Kevin Thomas Neff Scholarship was awarded to Anthony Gore.

The Jane Klenotic Scholarship honors long-time St. Hilary School second grade teacher Jane Klenotic, who lost her battle with cancer in 2014. The Jane Klenotic Scholarship Fund enables the Foundation to provide a \$1,000 award each spring to a second grader who has the attributes of spiritual, academic and personal character that were important to Jane. Katie Ann Bickett was the second grader chosen to receive the 2017-Ž018 Jane Klenotic Scholarship. The Jimmy Lyons Geography Bee Scholarship Fund was begun in

memory of St. Hilary School 2006 graduate Jimmy Lyons, who won the school's geography bee for four consecutive years between 2003 and 2006, was a state bee competitor, and passed away in 2011. This \$500 scholarship is awarded to the winner of the School's geography bee each year, going to Ryan Roman in January 2018.

Additionally, two \$500 St. Hilary Athletic Association scholarships are awarded through the Foundation each year to two St. Hilary School eighth grade student athletes who have participated in at least two St. Hilary athletic programs during their eighth grade school year, achieved first or second academic honors during the first, second, and third quarters of their eighth grade year, demonstrate good conduct and sportsmanship on and off the field of play, demonstrate and model Catholic values and morals, and are continuing their education at a Catholic high school. The scholarships are applied to the recipients' high school tuition. In May 2018, Olivia Scott and Steven Scott received these scholarships.

Looking to the Future

These scholarships would not be possible without the generosity of donors who share their blessings with the St. Hilary Parish Foundation. The Foundation relies upon each donor to augment its funds and enable continued support of St. Hilary School and its students. With the present and future needs of both the school and the parish in mind, the Foundation must work to maintain its resources at levels that will allow it to keep pace with these financial demands and safeguard the future. begun in the church over a year ago with fresh paint on all the walls and faux finishing in the shrines.

Supporting the School and its Students

The St. Hilary Parish Foundation again provided financial assistance to support students whose families desire a Catholic education at St. Hilary School. Scholarships totaling \$30,250.00 were awarded to students to be applied to 2018-2019 tuition. Please see page 8 for more information about these scholarships. Additionally, the Foundation granted \$25,000.00 in tuition assistance funds to be distributed to families with substantiated financial need. Without this assistance, the recipients of these funds might otherwise not be able to continue their education at St. Hilary School.

Another project the Foundation funded on behalf of the school was for the purpose of ensuring the safety of the students and staff in the building each day. Security has become an increasingly costly priority. Last spring, five additional cameras were installed in various locations inside and outside the school building. To accommodate observing the 11 cameras that keep a watchful eye on the school campus, a large flat screen monitor was also installed in the school office. The total cost of this security upgrade was \$7,240.67.

Just as school security has become increasingly reliant on technology, so has the business of educating students and keeping the school community informed. Along those lines, the Foundation also supplied \$7,619.00 for the purchase of Chromebooks for student use and a re-design of the school's website, last overhauled five years ago.

A few smaller school-related items funded by the Foundation in the past year include faculty and staff Christmas appreciation at \$4,256.60, buses for field trips at \$1,500.00, rosaries given to departing 8th grade families and funding toward the 8th grade awards luncheon at \$1,499.35, financial assistance for Latchkey fees at \$1,000.00, and Grandparents' Day hospitality at \$500.00.

Strengthening Parish Ministries

Providing funding to assist parish ministries in doing their work is another way in which the Foundation is blessed to support

the parish. A total of \$13,258.04 was given to support evangelization efforts and education for religious vocations, two causes of utmost importance in sharing the Catholic faith. In addition, \$9,902.53 was supplied to purchase a new piano for the choir room and to fund *Lessons and Carols* and *Laetare* concerts at the parish. And finally, *YOUCAT* books were purchased for use by PSR students at a cost of \$2,730.54.
