to come. Ironically, Jean, who had remained anonymous for years as she quietly donated funds to support various parish improvements, had decided just weeks before her death to reveal her legacy. Her story was told in last year's annual report.

PASTOR'S MESSAGE:

Legacy

My Dear Parishioners and Benefactors:

On Tuesday, September 25th, the St. Hilary Parish staff and the leaders of our over 100 ministries gathered at Furnace Run Metropark for an evening

of reflection and the unveiling of our five year pastoral plan for St. Hilary Parish. The evening began with a presentation by parishioner Dennis Kowalski on "Forming our Legacy". Dennis spoke of legacy as a set of values and meaning that is so significant to our lives that we are compelled to both preserve it and share it with future generations. Dennis reminded us, however, that the future direction of our legacy, is not automatically guaranteed, without a purposeful commitment and active plan to make it happen! What is the legacy of your life?

What is the legacy of our Parish? What steps are you individually and we together actively pursuing to ensure our legacy for future generations?

Fortunately, the leadership of St. Hilary Parish was thinking about this many years ago. Under the direction of our first pastor, Fr. Edward Horning, and a dedicated group of parishioners, the St. Hilary Parish Foundation was established. The purpose of this foundation was to raise and invest funds that would be available to future generations of parishioners for the support of major projects and ministries. These leaders were motivated by the desire to ensure that things like Catholic education, vibrant worship, athletic opportunities, and social outreach, all hallmarks of the St. Hilary Parish Legacy, would be preserved for future generations. They also were committed to supporting the future growth of both ministries and buildings on our beautiful campus. Could those early leaders have ever imagined that St. Hilary parish would have 114 ministries in 2012, and have completed and paid for four additions to the church and school buildings over the past 50 years? Perhaps they could have, since they were thinking toward the future when they established the Foundation in 1976!

Today there are continued opportunities for ensuring

our parish and school legacy. The St. Hilary Parish Foundation has specifically established The St. Hilary Legacy Society. This society consists of individuals who have made long-term commitments to the St. Hilary Parish Foundation through planned or deferred gift arrangements. This might include naming the Foundation as a beneficiary of your will or life insurance policy. This is a great option for individuals who may not be able to make a donation to the Foundation now because of present obligations, but who may want to do so at the time of their passing. Others may want to make a planned gift because of a passion for a particular ministry that they want to be able to support for many years to come. Consider becoming a member of the Legacy Society by contacting Diane Sarkis, Foundation Development Director, or me. If you have already named St. Hilary as a beneficiary of your will or life insurance policy, please let us know so we can include your name on the new Legacy Society plaque hanging by the parish office entrance.

Many of us regard our Catholic faith as one of the greatest gifts we have been given, and have a strong desire to ensure that Catholic legacy for future generations. I encourage you to explore how you are actively engaged in assuring that legacy, and invite you to support that legacy through the St. Hilary Parish Foundation. Crystal Commemoratives Update

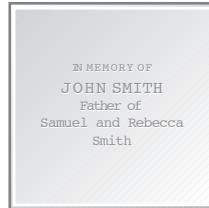
Commitments and pledges are already over 45%, with installation of first and second sets of committed panels in place.

Crystal Commemoratives are unique, individually crafted, etched and beveled glass panels, installed over the windows in the connecting hallway between the school and the gymnasium. They are a perfect way to leave a legacy, remember a loved one or celebrate a special event.

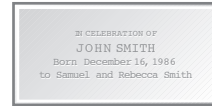
Three sizes offer a choice of participation levels, with the two larger sizes featuring bigger typography for the commemoration.

There are 86 6"x6" panels remaining available for a donation of \$2,500 each, 35 12"x6" panels remaining available for a donation of \$5,000 each, and only 31 12"x12" panels left available for a donation of \$10,000 each. If all are pledged, these commemorative panels will help raise over \$1,200,000 for the St. Hilary School Endowment Fund.

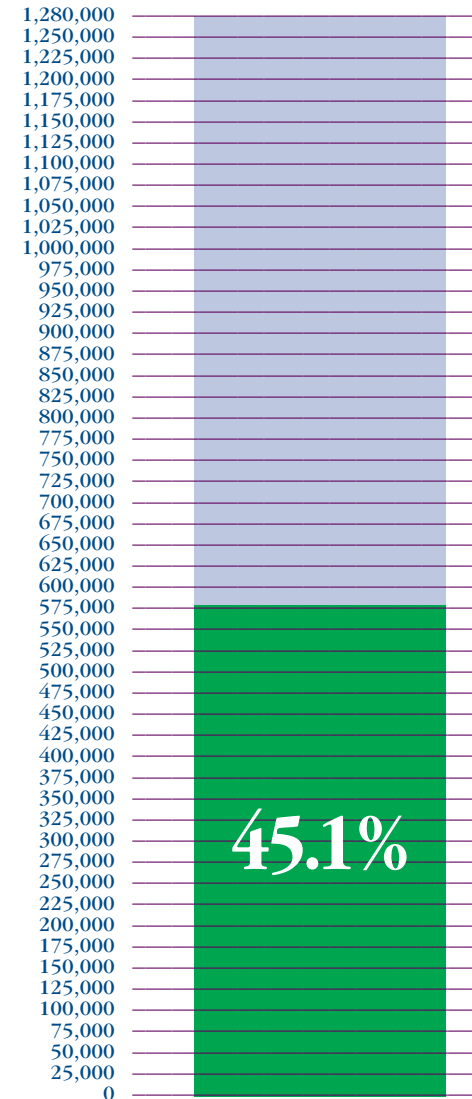

ST. HILARY SCHOOL :
Our Foundation helps ensure school viability for the future

Planning for the future is an important part of what the St. Hilary Parish Foundation does. By making gifts today, the Foundation supports needs that transcend the present and ensure longevity for years to come. In the case of our Parish school, it is crucial to support initiatives that will keep the building in sound condition for generations yet to come.

Following up on its 2011 funding of VCT flooring, carpeting, and concrete upgrades at the school, the Foundation helped to fund an even larger-scale project this year, by supporting the installation of a new boiler unit and air conditioning in the school. Sixty thousand dollars in Foundation funds were used to help replace the school's failing boiler, update ductwork and climate control systems throughout the school, and make possible for the first time the installation of air conditioning in the building.

Equally important in looking to the future is ensuring that the school's technology needs are met. The Foundation supported the purchase of over \$15,074 in new computers for teachers in 2012. This funding, coupled with over \$30,000 in funds raised at the annual St. Hilary Celebration and earmarked for student laptops and iPads, will help to ensure that instructional technology stays current.

Two additional school-related items were funded through Foundation generosity in 2012. These gifts



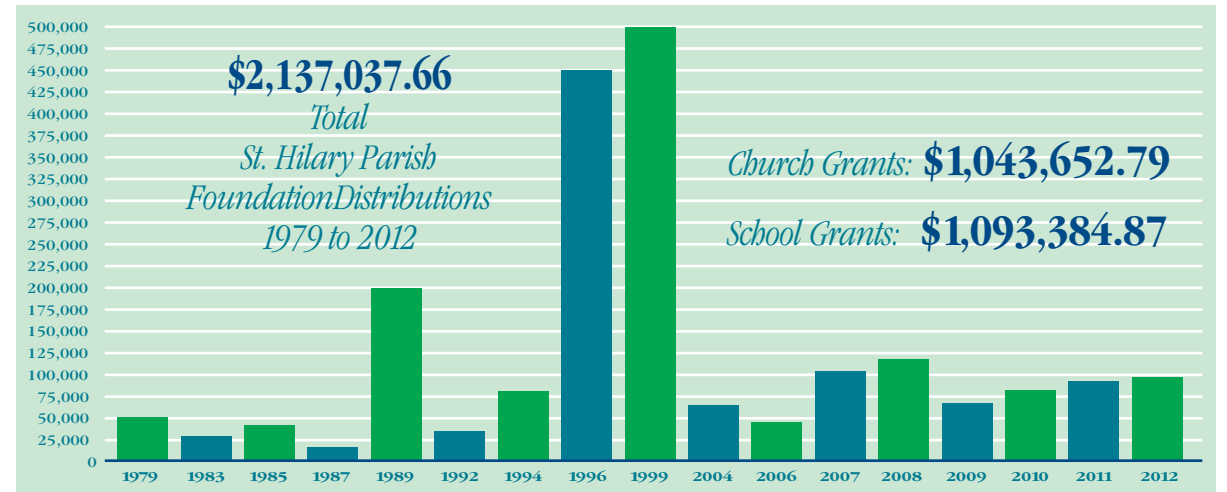
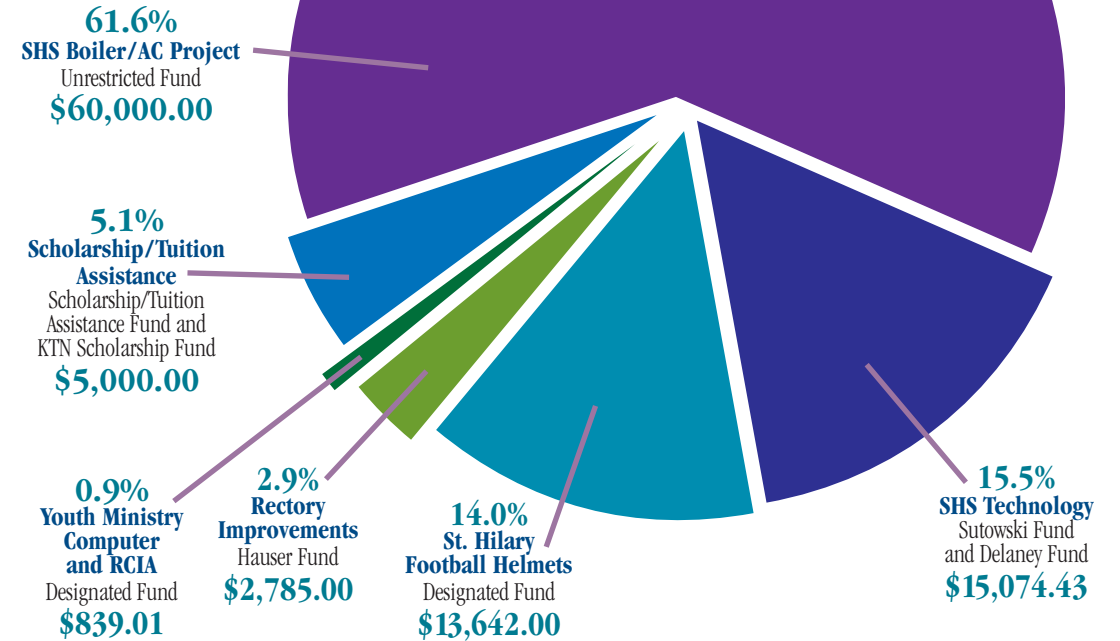
directly benefited students currently enrolled in the school. Four thousand dollars in tuition assistance made a St. Hilary School education possible for students who might otherwise not have had that opportunity. Also, a \$1,000 Kevin Neff Memorial Scholarship was awarded to current St. Hilary School eighth grader Matthew Kunas. This scholarship, which honors the memory of deceased St. Hilary School alumnus Kevin Neff, annually recognizes one St. Hilary School student who exemplifies the ideals Kevin aspired to during his life.

These and many other Foundation contributions are made possible each year through your generous giving. Without your support, our school and our parish would not be able to provide the many amenities from which our St.

Hilary community benefits. Our school staff, students and parents are especially grateful for the funding provided by the Foundation through your charitable donations.
